**HANCOCK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' RESOLUTION  
TO REDESIGN AND RENOVATE THE EXISTING JAIL**

**WHEREAS**, the Hancock County Board of Commissioners recognize the need to renovate and redesign the existing jail so that it might be utilized once the current construction project on the new jail is completed;

**WHEREAS**, the Hancock County Board of Commissioners recognize that it is in the best interest of the County and its residents to repurpose the old jail: in order to facilitate the continued efforts by the County to best utilize the assets and resources at its disposal;


**WHEREAS**, the Hancock County Board of Commissioners recognize that once the construction on the new jail is completed, it would be appropriate and necessary to have the old jail repurposed for Hancock County Community Corrections and Probation, and understand that it will be necessary for a general obligation bond to be issued for this purpose.


