**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Hancock County, Indiana, (“Board”) recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within Hancock County; and


**WHEREAS**, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) to provide grants to local units of government to improve the quality of life of its residents with projects that focus on their overall health and safety; and


**WHEREAS**, the Board has conducted a public hearing prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA), said public hearing to assess the economic needs of its low and moderate-income residents.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board that the President of the Board is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to implement and administer a small business revolving loan fund, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
